### Grade 9

Martin has grown into a confident, mature, and incredibly intelligent young man at Ibex Hill. This is most evident in his continuously impressive marks. At the end of term one, Martin finished at the top of his class with top marks in seven subjects! Martin struggled with an eye ulcer throughout much of term three, visiting the eye hospital on numerous occasions and needing to take several weeks off from school. However, at the end of the year, Martin received an award for second position in the grade nine class. This is a clear sign of Martin's will and determination as a student. He has also become a role model for the younger students, particularly those in KF, who describe him as "inspiring." Martin completed his national grade 9 exams in November, and is expecting impressive results. His teachers describe him as a very intelligent and dedicated student, and expect him to continue excelling during grade 10.

#### Grade 10

Martinho has had a spectacular year so far at Ibex Hill. Academically he has established himself as consistently ranking in the top three of his class.
