

PHYSICAL LOCATION

Chalo Trust School, a Christian, Boarding, Co-education school, is located in Lusaka's Chamba Valley, behind Hybrid Poultry Farm. It is off Great East Road, about fifteen minutes drive both from town and the airport. (Turn left at PHH roundabout from town and right from airport). This is a natural and serene environment suitable for serious and uninterrupted study, conferences, seminars and camps.

You could be saving life and money by avoiding long distance drives to pick up and drop your child. Take advantage of the proximity of Chalo Trust School. At CTS we allow you to visit your child once a month or whenever, they are sick and may need parental care and attention.

OUR ACADEMIC PHILOSOPHY

Our mission is to "Create an environment of order, truth, care and concern where students of diverse economic, cultural and spiritual backgrounds live together and prepare for tertiary education by beginning the habit of life long learning, personal and spiritual development".

At Chalo Trust School, we believe that education should inspire a love for learning and prepare individuals to make a positive contribution to the local environment and the world at large.

We further believe that education should be broad, balanced, integrated and comprise effective acquisition of academic and practical skills and knowledge and cultivate a healthy relationship both with man and God.



THE CURRICULUM

The school offers a broad general secondary curriculum. In grade 8 and 9, where the aim is to introduce children to a wide range of subjects. Each pupil is expected to take a total of 12/13 subjects of which 9 are core and compulsory; 2 are elective and, 2 compulsory and non-examinable. At this level, we offer the Zambian syllabus. This is to enable those that might elect to leave Chalo after grade 9 to go back to the Government or other schools, where the requirement for anyone to sit the grade 12 examination is a grade 9 certificate.

From Grade 10 to Grade 12, pupils focus on the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) curriculum. This is a Cambridge based programme which allows students to go to any university in the world. At this level, pupils are required to take a minimum of 8 examinable and 2 non-examinable subjects as outlined below.

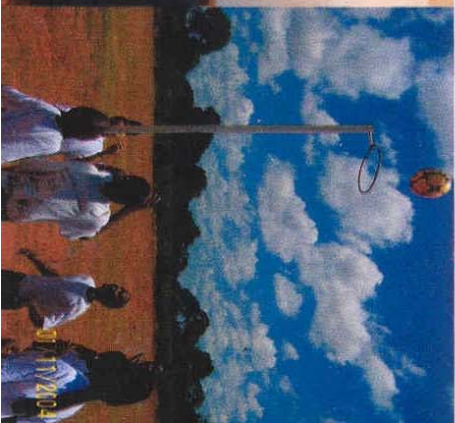

Morality and Leadership Training

All pupils are exposed to a compulsory course in moral issues and cultural aspects of the Zambian situation. In this course pupils discover about acceptable conduct in their daily life both in and outside school; they learn about respect for elders, respect for other people and responsibility roles in different settings including home, work, school, church and among peers.

CLASSROOMS/CLASS SIZE

There are three blocks, each with four ultra-modern classrooms. The blocks are connected by concrete walk-way in order to make movement from one block to another during the rainy season easy. Each pupil is entitled to one lockable desk. In order to provide maximum contact and help from teachers, the class size is restricted to LESS than 30 pupils at all levels.

STAFFING



The school boasts of a very experienced and qualified crop of teachers from very renown schools around the country these are not just well qualified and experienced but also self motivated men and women. You can be rest assured that your child will receive both academic and moral development at Chalotrust School because we give holistic education. At CTS each child is significant and important and known by their name.

BOARDING FACILITIES

The school has state of the art hostel facilities with splash-back ceramic tiles in all sanitary accommodation, untraveled in Zambia. The floor is decorated with a layer of clay and ceramic tiles, which give a sense of comfort, hygiene and homeliness. All the windows are steel-framed and burglar proofed. It is indeed "Home away from home," as the saying goes.

Each hostel has a resident houseparent who provides pastoral care, guidance and basic medical care. The school does laundry for the pupils but only for school uniforms and linen. Pupils, in order to encourage them to take responsibility, are encouraged to do part of their own laundry. This indeed is the essence of boarding life, that our children must learn to do what they do not do at home where maids and servants do everything for them.

CHRISTIAN ETHOS

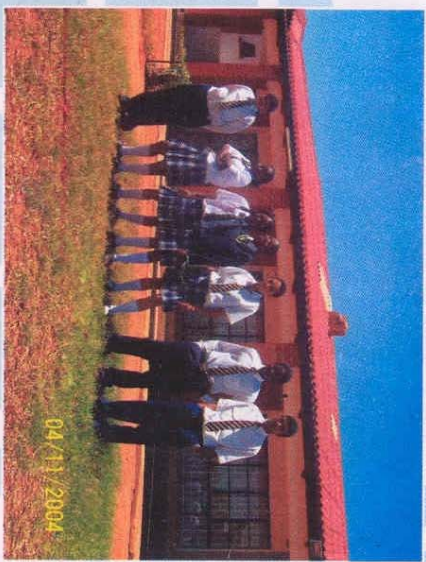
