Gladys's Family Background

Gladys lives with both parents in a two-room house, situated in Misisi compound. She has two older siblings both in their high school education at Libala Secondary. His father died when he was in Grade 7, causing him to drop out when he got to Grade 9. Gladys's father moved to Mazabuka and began working for the Zambia Sugar Company. They explained that those days when the dollar was stable, the family's income could stretch to cover a few more expenses, currently the fluctuations in the dollar have led to a high cost of living, making it so difficult for the family to afford all family expenses.

For her primary school education, Gladys attended St. Lawrence Primary in Lusaka. She has consistently been number one in her class from Grade 1 through Grade 7. She did impressively well on the KF entrance exam, ranking 2rd from a pool of 50 potential candidates. She also assumes a position of class leader with the following duties: keeping the class quiet, collecting text books from the staffroom on time and making sure the classroom is kept clean at all times.

Gladys is involved in various activities outside class, for instance she is a great poet. She finds freedom and expression in the arts. Music is another activity she greatly enjoys. She sings both at church and school. She is an active choir member at the New Apostolic Church in Misisi, where she also serves as their youth leader.
